

The vision of the AgrAbility Program is to assist farmers, ranchers, other agricultural workers, and farm family members impacted by disability. Each year, AgrAbility staff members in 25 states provide a variety of services to this clientele, including on-farm assessments, educational events, and information/referral services.

To support both AgrAbility staff members and their clients, the National AgrAbility Project holds the annual **AgrAbility National Training Workshop (NTW),** the premier event addressing issues of disability in agriculture. The NTW provides education and training through plenary sessions, breakout sessions, and tours.

The next NTW will be held March 25-28, 2019 in Lincoln, Nebraska. In previous years, our conference has been attended by up to 226 people representing 38 states, more than 60 of whom were farmers on scholarship. Additionally, we have had representatives from Canada, Sweden, Finland, China, and Brazil in attendance. These numbers represent records for the conference that we expect to continue to rise.
