

THE ADA NATIONAL NETWORK

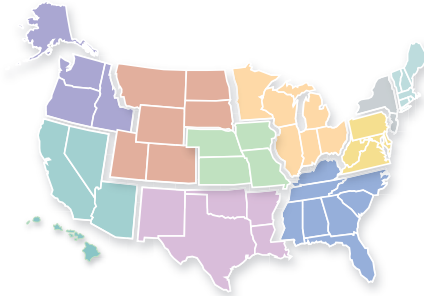

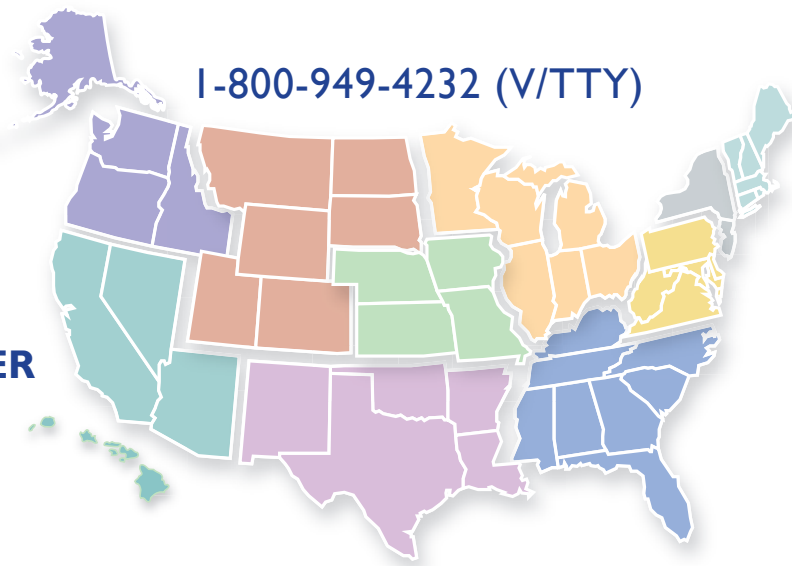
