- January 14, 1866
 - 62nd-65th Colored Infantry
 - \$6,400
 - The monies should be used to benefit freed African- Americans
 - Located in Missouri
 - Combine study and Labor

History cont...

- In 1877 college level work was added to the curriculum
- 1879 state property was deeded
- Second Morrill Act 1890, Lincoln became a land grant institution
