
Who Are FVC's Members?








Race/Ethnicity

- 20 partnerships with State Departments of Agriculture












Farmer Veteran Fellowship Fund

- Small grant program that provides direct assistance to veterans who are in their beginning years of farming or ranching.
- Awards range from \$1,000 to \$5,000; more than \$3 million has been awarded to veterans since 2011.
- Equipment purchases made on behalf of recipients, and often make critical differences in beginning military producer's operation.
