- Founded in 2009 | Based in Woodland, California











#### **GENDER**




#### **RACE & ETHNICITY**

# **Farmer Veteran Fellowship Fund**

- Small grant program that provides direct assistance to farmer veterans with awards of \$1,000 to \$5,000
  - Purchases made on behalf of farmer veteran for equipment and other related supplies
  - Application opens at beginning of year with purchases made in the spring
- Established in 2011 and has awarded \$3.5 million in grants to more than 800 farmer veterans
- Major sponsors include Wounded Warrior Project, Kubota Tractor Corporation, Tractor Supply Co., and Farm Credit System

- In partnership with Kubota Tractor Corporation, the Geared to Give program provides equipment and grants through the **Fellowship Fund**
- Each year, Kubota awards five pieces of equipment through the Geared to Give program
- Since 2015, Geared to Give program has awarded 31 pieces of equipment to Farmer Veteran Coalition members















# **Homegrown By Heroes Label**

- Official farmer veteran branding program of America
- Certifies ranchers, farmers, foresters and fishermen to sell their products as veteran-owned and produced
- 20 partnerships with State Departments of Agriculture

## AgCareers.com

- AgCareers.com is an international placement agency that provides talent solutions for the agriculture and food industries.
- In Q1 2022, FVC is rolling out a partnership with AgCareers.com to help members find remote, off-farm jobs in agriculture.
- AgCareers.com operates Ag Warriors program that assists veterans in their search of careers in the agriculture and food industries—FVC will be incorporated into this program.
- FVC will host a plug-in on our website where members can search and apply for jobs.

## **Career Certification Pathway Program**

- Initial pilot program with Kubota Tractor Corporation is underway, but also working with other agricultural industry leaders to build out offerings.
- Kubota program focuses on technician jobs which require specialized certifications.
- Once certification is complete, veterans receive job placement assistance to fill 1,800 jobs at Kubota dealerships across the country.









# Enhancing Agricultural Opportunities for Military Veterans (AgVets)

- Provides grants to nonprofits to increase the number of military
  veterans gaining knowledge and skills through comprehensive, handson and immersive model farm and ranch programs offered regionally
  that lead to successful careers in the food and agricultural sector.
- FVC awarded for 2021-2024 grant period
  - Objective to train at least 150 veterans through four partner programs:
    - Archi's Acres
    - Rodale Institute
    - Dairy Grazing Apprenticeship
    - Battleground to Breaking Ground








# **Cooperative Agreement Mobilizing Veterans to Feed America**

- This grant supports USDA's historic commitment to lower barriers to access USDA programming to help underserved producers succeed.
- FVC will coordinate with other cooperators to focus on the needs of farmer and rancher veteran members through:
  - Financial literacy
  - Introduction to USDA programs
  - Market planning
  - Technical farming and peer support

- FVC partnered with NAAF to gather critical input from Native
   American U.S. military veterans working in the agricultural industry
- Goal of partnership is to evaluate responses from the NAAF veteran survey which will be incorporated into a final report that will assist NAAF with their plan, "Reimagining Native Food Economies," which is detailed here:

- Plan includes developing 10 regional food hubs throughout the country to provide native producers the infrastructure to create selfsustaining food systems for native and rural communities


