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- My Story
- Hired in 2014 for the National and Indiana AgrAbility Projects
- Part of 3 year Beginning Farmer Rancher Development project at Purdue University.
   Planned and hosted numerous Workshops and Farm tours for Veterans
- Started chapter of the Farmer Veteran Coalition in 2017
  - HGH and Indiana Grown combined label, presented by Indiana governor
- Able to combine the efforts of the FVC-IN with the services that Indiana AgrAbility can provide
- Over time, became the POC for Veterans in Agriculture at Purdue, Indiana state government agencies (Indiana Dept of Veterans Affairs, Indiana Department of Agriculture), USDA state offices and most VSOs.
- Indiana AgVets project and other projects






# Agraphic Accessible Agriculture

### Mentoring and Job Coaching

- Interns assigned a job coach/mentor
  - Develop personalized curriculum
  - Guidance throughout program
- Internship host mentor
  - Coordinates with project staff and intern
  - Serves as on-site mentor
- Disability services
  - AgrAbility assists AgVets and host sites to ensure accessibility
  - Counselors & mentors for service-related challenges (PTSD)

















# Agrading Accessible Agriculture

### AgVets Internships

- Stipends paid
- Interns may be placed at:
  - Grain, livestock, or specialty farms
  - Agribusinesses such as crop services, grain handling, machinery dealers, etc.
  - Nurseries, turf & landscape operations, forest products
  - Depends on AgVet's interests!
- Purdue Agricultural Centers partnership
- Support from Indiana agribusinesses, ag. organizations
- Sites throughout Indiana








